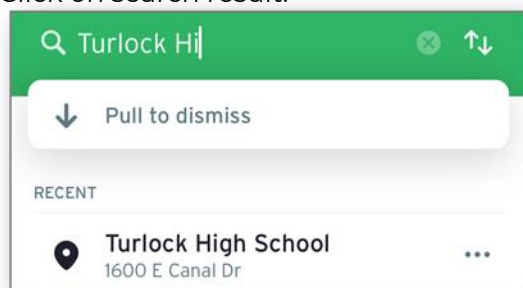

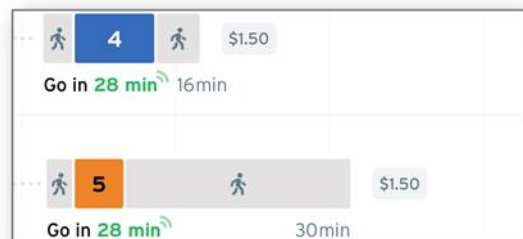

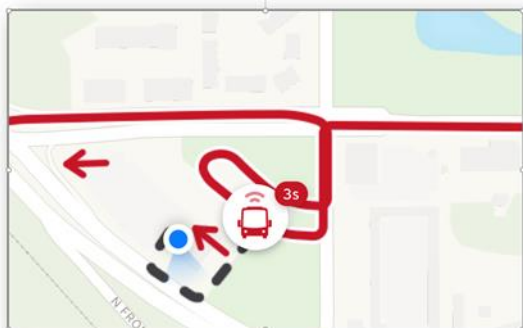

- Children under 9 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.
- Please use headphones to not disrupt others.
- Pets must be in a carrier and held on your lap or under seat.
- No weapons of any kind.
- No smoking on buses or at bus stops.
- No profanity or unruly behavior
- Avoid talking or distracting the driver while the bus is in motion.
- Please observe priority seating for seniors and individuals with disabilities.

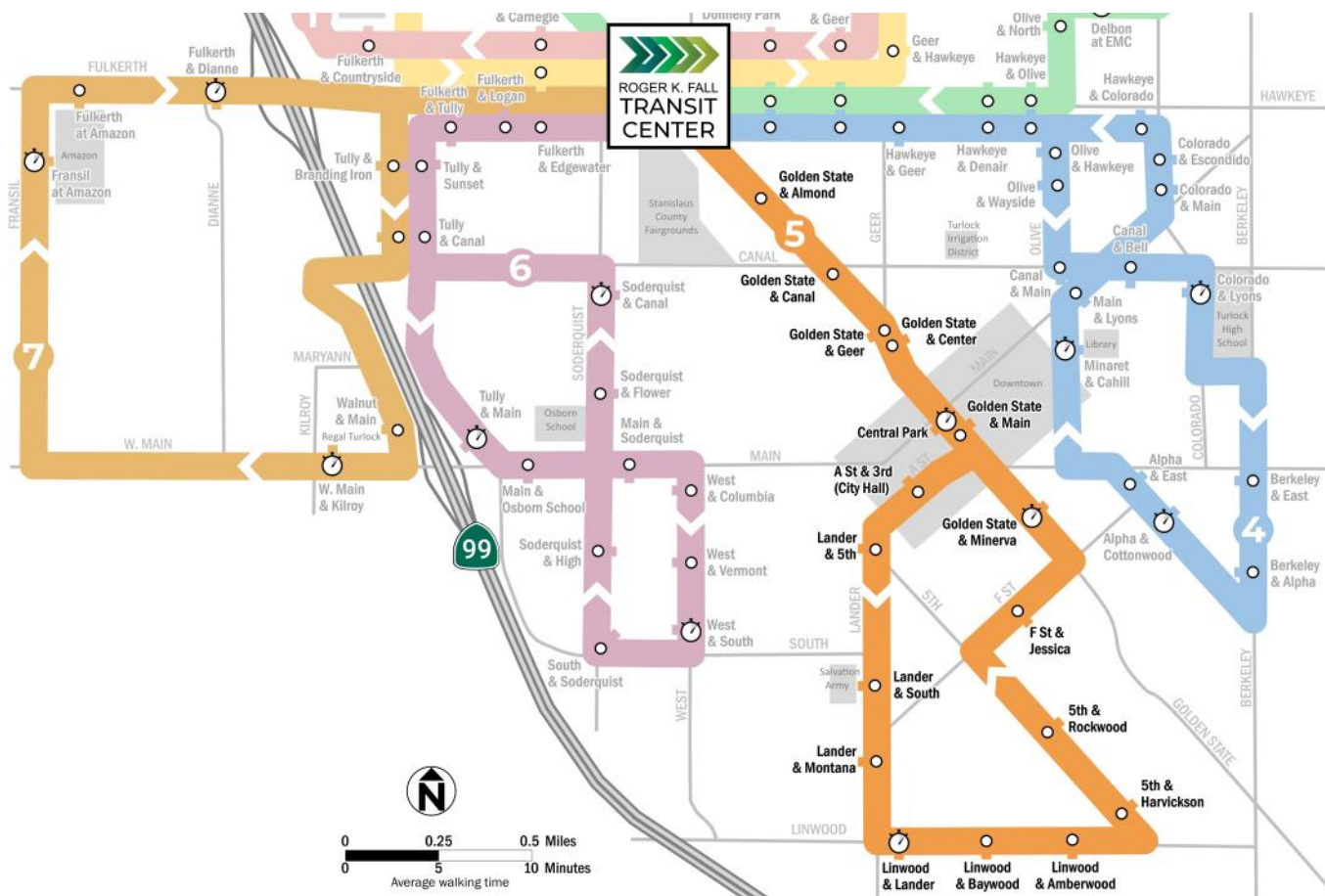
