Ultimately, the goal is to keep improving Turlock Transit. That means enhancing bus routes, making bus schedules more convenient, and providing a seamless rider experience.

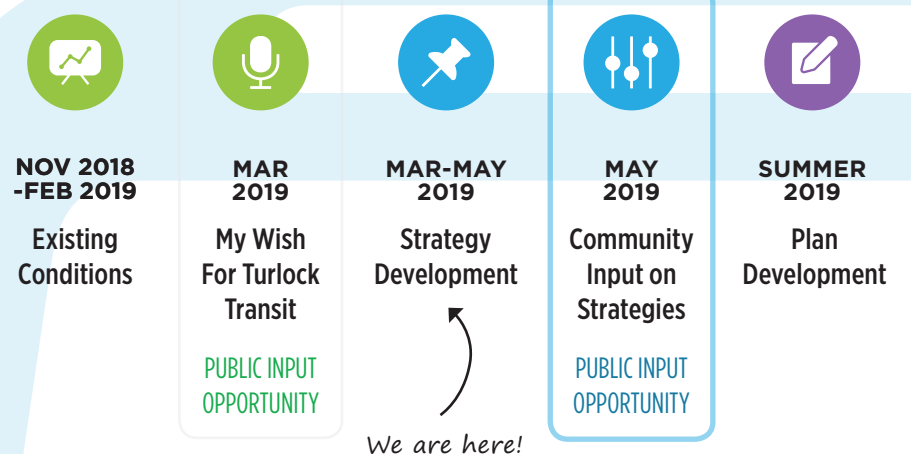
